1. **Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, 2025** Colognola ai Colli, Veneto, Italy £31.00 ©
Fresh and fruity Pinot Grigio exuding gentle flavours of pears, peaches and nuts and the scent of fresh flowers.
2. **Wykeham French White: Côtes du Roussillon Blanc 'Chemin de Garriu', 2024** Roussillon, France £37.50 ©
This delicious dry white is wonderfully concentrated with floral and fleshy white fruit aromas and an opulent, silky texture. Delicious on it's own but also a versatile match for a variety of dishes. (Grenache Blanc - Macabeu - Rolle)
3. **Les Courtines Grand Réserve Blanc, 2022** Gascony, France £30.00
Racy, fresh and fragrant with plenty of upfront zesty fruit.
4. **Gewurztraminer, 2023** Domaine Henry Fuchs, Ribeauvillé, Alsace, France £42.00
Very aromatic with delicious exotic fruits and a lime fresh palate with a touch of honey on the finish.
5. **Rioja Blanco, 2025** Bodegas Muga, Haro, Rioja Alta, Spain £43.00
Citrus, pineapple and apple aromas lead into a firm body and complex mouthfeel with lovely peachy flavours and hints of spice.
6. **Macon Blanc Davayé, 2024** Domaine G. Saumaize, Burgundy, France £50.00 ©
This wine has a lovely, lemony crispness married to that typical Maconnais floweriness.
7. **Sancerre 'Chavignol', 2025** Domaine Serge Laporte, Chavignol, Loire Valley, France £55.00 ©
Classic Sancerre with all the chalkiness and gooseberry steely fruit typical of Chavignol wines.
8. **Chablis, 2022** Domaine Long-Depaquit, Burgundy, France £54.00
Clean and elegant with intense aromas of candied lemon, subtle hints of white flowers and a lively mineral finish.
9. **Montagny 1er Cru Buissonnier, 2022** Cave de Buxy, Côte Chalonnaise, Burgundy, France £56.00
Deep flavoured, textured white Burgundy from one of the region's most reliable producers. Although very ripe, this classic wine has a scintillating, refreshing acidity.
10. **Chateau Lamothe-Bouscalt, 2020** Pessac-Leognan Blanc, Bordeaux, France £69.00
Opulent white Bordeaux from one of the most highly regarded producers in Pessac-Léognan. A 70/30 blend of Sauvignon and Semillon, this wine is layered and complex, with aromas of ripe citrus and stone fruits coupled with subtle notes of vanilla and fresh pastries from the well-integrated oak.
11. **Saint-Aubin 1er Cru 'La Chatenière, 2023** Domaine Gérard Thomas & Filles, Burgundy, France £88.00 ©
Fantastically well balanced and complex. Gérard Thomas barrel ferments this wine to give it a softer and smoother complexity. A nose of ripe citrus, fresh peach and a touch of sweet spice, with hints of vanilla and butter on the opulent palate.
12. **Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'Clos Roquette', 2022** F&D Brunier, Southern Rhône, France £89.00
Utterly captivating Southern Rhone white from the esteemed Famille Brunier of Vieux Telegraphe fame. Wonderfully aromatic with spring flowers and flint on the nose and a silky and harmonious palate. [Clairette - Grenache Blanc - Roussanne]
13. **Chassagne-Montrachet 'Les Champs de Morjot', 2022** Château de la Charrière, Burgundy, France £92.00
Yves and Benoit Girardin are making some fabulous wines at the family estate in Santenay. Their Chassagne shows concentrated citrus aromas and white stone fruit intermingled with toasted notes. Rich and full in the mouth with wonderful length and great precision.
14. **Chablis Grand Cru 'Les Clos', 2022** Domaine Pinson, Burgundy, France £120.00
A Grand Cru Chablis is the very pinnacle of great Chablis and Les Clos is recognised as being one of the best grand cru sites. With Pinson's Les Clos you get richness of fruit without too much fatness. Laurent is not looking to disguise the inherent concentration and ripeness in his wines by exposing them to too much oak. Oak is there but in a supporting role.
15. **Puligny-Montrachet 1^{er} Cru 'Les Clavoillons', 2022** Domaine J-L Chavy, Burgundy, France £160.00
Jean Louis Chavy's scrupulous attention to detail, and desire to keep to low yields, have secured him a reputation for great Puligny with each of the Premier Crus showing off their typicity and 'terroir'. The Clavoillons is an incredibly profound wine with massively concentrated fruit and a marginally higher dose of oak. The vines are 50 years old which further adds richness and dimension to the wine.
16. **Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru, 2019** Domaine Françoise André, Burgundy, France £195.00
Recently selected as the Guide Hachette's Beaune Winemakers of the Year, this family-owned and -run estate is one of the few remaining domaines to vinify within the walls of Beaune. Their Corton-Charlemagne is the jewel in the crown of their impressive stable of red and white Burgundies. A timeless classic showing strength and poise with a nose of white blossom and toasted nuts and a lengthy palate of rich, buttery fruit.

A decidedly drinkable, vibrant and juicy red from the 'heel' of Italy, packed full of bright red fruit with hints of fruitcake spice.
47. **Wykeham French Red: Domaine de Cassagnau, 2023** IGP Pays d'Oc, France £36.00 ©
A soft, velvety blend of Syrah, Grenache and Merlot packed with spicy bramble fruit and hints of Mediterranean herbs.

57. **Côte de Nuits Villages 'VI', 2023** Domaine Xavier Durand, Burgundy, France £74.00 ©
An open, flamboyant Pinot Noir with ripe, integrated tannins with a fine finish from an outstanding producer.
58. **Barolo 'Ascheri', 2019** Michele Reverdito, Piedmont, Italy £89.00
An intense and complex bagful of flavours and aromas. Still mellow, full of autumnal fruits and dark cherries with a touch of cinnamon.
59. **Château Siran, 2017** Margaux, Bordeaux, France £98.00 ©
Situated in the far south of the Margaux appellation, Chateau Siran has a growing following for their wines which are classically elegant in character with a good ripeness of fruit, hints of vanilla and silky smooth tannins.
60. **Gevrey-Chambertin, 2022** Domaine Paul Chavy, Burgundy, France £110.00
From the son of renowned Puligny vigneron, Jean-Louis Chavy, this is a rich and powerful Gevrey, packed with dark berry fruit, lovely earthy undertones, with perfectly balanced acidity and fine, firm tannins.
61. **Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'La Crau', 2019** Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe, Southern Rhône, France £125.00
Vieux Télégraphe is recognised as the one of the very best estates in Châteauneuf. Made predominantly from Grenache, the 'La Crau' is packed with dark cherry and bramble fruit laced with peppery garrigue, hints of liquorice and fruitcake spice.
62. **Nuits-St-Georges 'Les Charmois', 2023** Domaine Xavier Durand, Burgundy, France £98.00
A softer and more supple Pinot Noir than most Nuits-Saint-Georges. Complex earthy, meaty notes on the nose with a lush palate of ripe autumn fruit and excellent structure.
63. **Alter Ego de Palmer, 2005** 3ème Cru Classé Margaux, Bordeaux, France £250.00
The second wine of iconic Margaux estate, Chateau Palmer. The 2005 Alter Ego is silky and generous with plush ripe fruit and fragrant cedar wood notes.
64. **Château Gruaud-Larose, 2010** 2ème Cru Classé Saint-Julien, Bordeaux, France £190.00
From one of the most famous St Julien estates comes this gloriously dense and powerful 2010. Intense, concentrated blackberry and cassis fruit, overlaid with complex, spicy, earthy notes, finely-tuned tannins and superb freshness.

65. **Primitivo Appassimento** Linteo, Puglia, Italy £31.00
A blockbusting richly flavoured red with a good concentration of ripe plum and black cherry fruits.
66. **'Pouca Roupá'** Joao Romas, Alentejo, Portugal £36.50 ©
Soft, velvety tannins, medium-bodied with red fruit and a touch of florality for lift.
67. **Nebbiolo 'Argo'** Villadoria, DOC Langhe, Piedmont, Italy £38.00 ©
This 'baby Barolo' has a perfumed nose of violets, roses, cherries and raspberries. Assertive tannins with a balancing acidity and long finish.
68. **Ribera del Duero Roble, 2023** Protos, Ribera del Duero, Spain £46.00
Succulent, velvety and crammed full of blackberry fruitiness. Plums and spice burst from the glass with hints of liquorice.
69. **Chianti Classico, 2022** Borgo Salcetino, Radda-in-Chianti, Tuscany, Italy £58.00
Top notch Chianti from a classic, slow-ripening vintage. Deliciously ripe and juicy with vibrant flavours of tangy red cherry, sweet cassis, fig and roasted red pepper.
70. **Massaya 'Terrasses de Baalbeck', 2021** Massaya Estate, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon £60.00
A very elegant red with smoky, spicy fruit characters and a long, complex finish.
71. **Priorat 'Coma Vella', 2019** Mas d'En Gil, Tarragona, Catalunya, Spain £79.00
Old-vine Garnacha and Cariñena flourish on extremely poor soils resulting in a soft, supple red with bags of personality. This is a smoky, dense and intense red with spicy fruit. Nicknamed the 'Pomerol of Spain', it is perfect with roast meats or game.
72. **Brunello di Montalcino, 2020** Camigliano, Tuscany, Italy £95.00 ©
An impressive and well-balanced Brunello from a very good vintage. Warm, sun-ripened cherry and berry fruit characters are underpinned by classic notes of liquorice, dried mushroom, toasted nuts and coffee bean. The palate shows impressive balance with perfectly integrated tannins and a long, slightly savoury finish.
73. **Barbaresco Asili, 2020** Ca' del Baio, Piedmont, Italy £98.00
An elegant, generous Barbaresco made from hand-picked grapes selected from prime areas of the Asili Cru. An intense, fruit-laden nose with notes of dried cherry, lavender, rose petal and aromatic herbs. The palate is soft and warm with velvety tannins and a long, dry finish.

74. **'Selkirk' Shiraz, 2021** Bremerton Estate, Langhorne Creek, South Australia £45.00
Complex aromas of vibrant red berry fruit and liquorice with well filled out clean fleshy fruit on the palate. Subtle use of oak has added complex creamy vanilla and fine underlying tannins.
75. **'The Vintage Widow' Pinot Noir, 2020** Jackson Estate, Marlborough, New Zealand £57.00
Pronounced cherry and raspberry aromas with lovely balance of fruit of the palate and a very elegant length.
76. **'The Barkly' Durif, 2016** Campbells, Rutherglen, Victoria, Australia £82.00
A dense, dark inky wine, this is Durif at its very finest. Rich and powerful with brooding plum and black cherry fruit, lifted notes of black pepper, cloves and spicy oak and fine-grained tannins.
77. **Coleraine, 2022** Te Mata Estate, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand £150.00
Rated (by the critics) as one of New Zealand's top five reds, this is a classic Bordeaux blend of 52% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Merlot, and 15% Cabernet Franc. Well structured and balanced with aromas of blackberries, currants and lavender. On the palate, it's superbly concentrated and elegantly layered, with tremendous fruit strength paired with complexity and detail and a long and intriguing finish.

78. **Altivo 'Classic' Malbec, 2024** Finca la Celia, Mendoza, Argentina £38.00 ©
Ripe and smooth with full, gutsy fruit and softening tannins.
79. **'Collection' Carmenère, 2024** Casas del Bosque, Rapel, Chile £40.00
An excellent example of this Chilean speciality. Aged for 10 months in French oak, it has a marvellous graphite quality reminiscent of the wines of Graves in Bordeaux. This brings a degree of freshness to the black cherry fruit which is wound round the heady notes of cedar, tobacco, cinnamon and plums.
80. **Merlot, Sandstone, 2021** Wentz Vineyards, Central Coast, California, USA £46.00
A classic Merlot with delicate aromatics including dark cherry, ripe raspberry and cocoa powder. Refined and well-balanced with subtle tannins, finishing with a bright, refreshing acidity.
81. **Zinfandel, 2022** Edmeades Winery, Mendocino County, California, USA £59.00 ©
Soft and supple with vivacious cherry fruit, this lovely red has a deep rural feel with great earthy notes and with a velvety complex structure.
82. **'TD-9', 2018** Shafer Vineyards, Stags Leap District, Napa Valley, California, USA £125.00
A juicy and aromatic blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot aged in new French oak. The palate is full-bodied and firm with vibrant raspberry, bramble and black cherry fruit, spicy floral and herbal notes and a long, savoury finish. The name 'TD-9' celebrates a bold move: In 1973, in the space of a few months, John Shafer went from riding morning commuter trains in Chicago to teaching himself to drive a TD-9 tractor in our Napa Valley vineyard. He'd never grown grapes or made wine in his life. That spirit of risk-taking and adventure still guides Shafer today and inspired the creation of this wine.
