WHITE WINES - European Classics

1. **Pinot Grigio 'Folio', 2023** Cantine Francesco Minini, Veneto, Italy £28.00
Pale straw in colour with light golden hues, it has a fruity bouquet and a subtle, fresh flavour.
2. **Wykeham French White: Côtes du Roussillon Blanc 'Chemin de Garriu', 2022** Roussillon, France £32.00
This delicious dry white has a floral bouquet and a surprisingly complex flavour, largely due to the use of a small amount of Malvoisie in the blend (90% Macabeo/10% Malvoisie).
3. **Verdejo Organico 'Paso a Paso', 2023** Bodegas Volver, La Mancha, Spain £33.00
Very fresh and aromatic with charming aromas of white flowers, ripe stone fruit and wild herbs.
4. **Les Courtines Grand Réserve Blanc, 2022** Gascony, France £29.00
Racy, fresh and fragrant with plenty of upfront zesty fruit.
5. **Gros Manseng, 2023** Domaine des Cassagnoles, Côtes de Gascogne, France £33.50
Delightfully crisp yet complex with a gorgeous acacia/pink grapefruit bouquet. The palate is lively and aromatic with touches of greengage, grapefruit and lime and a superb, long finish.
6. **Gewurztraminer, 2022** Domaine Henry Fuchs, Ribeauvillé, Alsace, France £38.00
Very aromatic with delicious exotic fruits and a lime fresh palate with a touch of honey on the finish.
7. **Rioja Blanco, 2023** Bodegas Muga, Haro, Rioja Alta, Spain £39.00
Citrus, pineapple and apple aromas lead into a firm body and complex mouthfeel with lovely peachy flavours and hints of spice.
8. **Macon Blanc Davayé, 2023** Domaine G. Saumaize, Burgundy, France £48.00
This wine has a lovely, lemony crispness married to that typical Maconnais floweriness.
9. **Sancerre 'Chavignol', 2022** Domaine Serge Laporte, Chavignol, Loire Valley, France £49.00
Classic Sancerre with all the chalkiness and gooseberry steely fruit typical of Chavignol wines.
10. **Chablis, 2021** Domaine Long-Depaquit, Burgundy, France £54.00
Clean and elegant with intense aromas of candied lemon, subtle hints of white flowers and a lively mineral finish.
11. **Montagny 1er Cru Buissonnier, 2022** Cave de Buxy, Côte Chalonnaise, Burgundy, France £55.00
Deep flavoured, textured white Burgundy from one of the region's most reliable producers. Although very ripe, this classic wine has a scintillating, refreshing acidity.
12. **Clos Floridene, 2019** Graves Blanc, Bordeaux, France £65.00
The 'insiders' dry white Bordeaux, made by the Dubourdieu family from 40 year-old vines ensuring the wine's complexity. Denis Dubourdieu was a professor of wine making at Bordeaux University, specialising in developing modern white wine making techniques. [50% Semillon, 40% Sauvignon and 10% Muscadelle]. Marvellous value!
13. **Saint-Aubin 1er Cru 'La Chatenière, 2022** Domaine Gérard Thomas & Filles, Burgundy, France £85.00
Fantastically well balanced and complex. Gérard Thomas barrel ferments this wine to give it a softer and smoother complexity. A nose of ripe citrus, fresh peach and a touch of sweet spice, with hints of vanilla and butter on the opulent palate.
14. **Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'Clos la Roquette', 2021** F&D Brunier, Southern Rhône, France £80.00
Utterly captivating Southern Rhone white from the esteemed Famille Brunier of Vieux Telegraphe fame. Wonderfully aromatic with spring flowers and flint on the nose and a silky and harmonious palate. [Clairette - Grenache Blanc - Roussanne]
15. **Chassagne-Montrachet 'Les Champs de Morjot', 2021** Château de la Charrière, Burgundy, France £90.00
Yves and Benoit Girardin are making some fabulous wines at the family estate in Santenay. Their Chassagne shows concentrated citrus aromas and white stone fruit intermingled with toasted notes. Rich and full in the mouth with wonderful length and great precision.
16. **Chablis Grand Cru 'Les Clos', 2021** Domaine Pinson, Burgundy, France £115.00
A Grand Cru Chablis is the very pinnacle of great Chablis and Les Clos is recognised as being one of the best grand cru sites. With Pinson's Les Clos you get richness of fruit without too much fatness. Laurent is not looking to disguise the inherent concentration and ripeness in his wines by exposing them to too much oak. Oak is there but in a supporting role.
17. **Puligny-Montrachet 1^{er} Cru 'Les Clavoillons', 2022** Domaine J-L Chavy, Burgundy, France £145.00
Jean Louis Chavy's scrupulous attention to detail, and desire to keep to low yields, have secured him a reputation for great Puligny with each of the Premier Crus showing off their typicity and 'terroir'. The Clavoillons is an incredibly profound wine with massively concentrated fruit and a marginally higher dose of oak. The vines are 50 years old which further adds richness and dimension to the wine.
18. **Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru, 2019** Domaine Françoise André, Burgundy, France £195.00
Recently selected as the Guide Hachette's Beaune Winemakers of the Year, this family-owned and run estate is one of the few remaining domaines to vinify within the walls of Beaune. Their Corton-Charlemagne is the jewel in the crown of their impressive stable of red and white Burgundies. A timeless classic showing strength and poise with a nose of white blossom and toasted nuts and a lengthy palate of rich, buttery fruit.

<i>Straw yellow with tints of olive green. Delicate aromas of waxy white flowers and almond are followed by a surprisingly full bodied, rich hit of spicy apple and lemon on the palate. Think freshwater fish and antipasti.</i> | £48.00 |
| 27. | Vouvray Sec 'Clos Cartaud', 2020 Domaine Pichot, Touraine, Loire, France
<i>Hand-harvested from two hectares of vines that are 45-50 years old, the Clos Cartaud is a wonderfully expressive, bone-dry Loire Chenin Blanc. Incredibly complex with notes of floral aromatics and ripe orchard fruit on the nose, the palate is succulent yet structured with fine chalky mineral notes and clean, lime-fresh acidity.</i> | £65.00 |
| 28. | Mas de Daumas Gassac Blanc, 2021 Famille Guibert, Aniane, Languedoc, France
<i>Mas de Daumas Gassac are true pioneers of quality winemaking in the Languedoc, regarded worldwide as the 'Grand Cru' of the region. Their 2021 white is a rich and unusual blend of 18 different grape varieties including Viognier, Chardonnay and Chenin Blanc. The result is a substantial wine which shows magnificent minerality and complex fruit aromas with a strong, zesty character and a wonderfully lengthy finish.</i> | £100.00 |

<i>Flavours of citrus, honeydew melon and ripe peach with a hint of nougat and cinnamon. A lovely creamy texture and great mineral acidity on the long finish.</i> | £34.00 |
| 31. | Sauvignon Blanc, 2023 Lanark Lane, Marlborough, New Zealand
<i>Intensely aromatic, crisp and fresh, this is classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Juicy gooseberry, lime and passionfruit flavours with grassy, green capsicum overtones and an exhilarating mineral acidity on the finish.</i> | £38.00 |

<i>The Contours Riesling is produced from old vines farmed on the coolest slope within the ruggedly beautiful Pewsey Vale vineyard. On the nose. intense lemon fruit aromas with a hint of white flowers; the palate has great length and depth with notes of zesty lime juice overlaid with toasted brioche and lime marmalade. | 35. | 'Te Koko' Sauvignon Blanc, 2019 Cloudy Bay, Marlborough, New Zealand
<i>Te Koko is a sophisticated, unique expression of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Crafted from just four prime vineyard parcels, it is fermented with wild yeasts and aged in French oak barrels. Serious, subtle and complex with a nuanced nose of citrus and stone fruits and savoury notes of soft woodsmoke.</i> | £110.00 |

36. **Chardonnay 'La Capitana', 2021** Viña La Rosa, Cachapoal, Chile £36.00
Full-flavoured, elegant white with notes of ripe peach and papaya and a pleasant citrus freshness.
37. **Viognier 'Serbal' 2024** Bodegas Atamisque, Tupungato, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina £38.00
Made in a really fresh, aromatic style, unoaked with lovely notes of honeysuckle and stone fruits on the nose. An intense full palate with excellent balancing acidity and a lovely silky texture.
38. **Bianco de Piel (Orange Wine), Extremo, 2023** Vallisto Salta, Argentina £45.00
White Torrontes grapes are left in contact with the skins to produce what is called an orange wine. Notes of orange blossom, dried apricot and ginger, supported by a lovely freshness with a dollop of orange marmalade on the finish.
39. **Chardonnay, Riva Ranch, 2021** Wente Vineyards, Arroyo Seco, Monterey, California, USA £55.00
A rich, golden colour with aromas and flavours of tropical fruit, honey, cinnamon and light floral notes, balanced by subtle oak, butter and vanilla from barrel aging. It has a round mouthfeel and a long, fruity finish.
40. **Albariño 2020** Marimar Estate, Russian River Valley, California, USA £68.00
Distinctive, clean aromas of Sicilian lemon, white peach and Asian pear, with light floral touches of jasmine and a minerality reminiscent of wet stones. The palate is rich, with bright acidity that follows through to a long, refreshing and crisp finish.
41. **Old Vine Chenin Blanc 'L'Isle Verte', 2018** Division-Villages, Yakima Valley, Washington, USA £72.00
The Division Winemaking Company's series of Division-Villages wines were inspired by the classics of France. From one of the few remaining plots of Chenin in the Pacific Northwest, this is reminiscent of a turbo-charged dry Vouvray. Silky smooth, deliciously savoury and mineral with notes of fresh lime, subtle hints of coconut and mushroom and a long zesty finish.

44. **Sauvignon Blanc 'Two Points', 2023** Western Cape £26.00
Fresh and zesty with notes of grapefruit and green apple on the nose. A light and fruity palate showing cut grass, passionfruit and guava flavours with a clean, refreshing finish.
45. **'Maestro' White, 2019** DeMorgenzon Estate, Stellenbosch £55.00
A fascinating Rhone-inspired blend including Roussanne, Chenin Blanc and Grenache Blanc. Full-bodied and complex with notes of concentrated orange and yellow stone fruits and a hint of spice, citrus and blossoms.
46. **Chardonnay 'Nine Yards', 2022** Jordan Estate, Stellenbosch £68.00
Aromas of butterscotch, spicy cloves and citrus peel. A rich mouthfeel and subtly balanced toasty French oak integrate with the long, tropical peach and melon finish.

Crisp, clean summer fruit flavours on the palate and a style that sits slightly on the sweeter side of off-dry.
51. **'Les Terrasses' Grenache/Merlot Rosé, 2023** Les Vignerons Ardéchois, Ardèche, France £32.00
A crisp, dry rosé from the foothills of the Cevennes mountains, full of fresh raspberry fruit with hints of cranberry and redcurrant.
52. **Côtes de Provence Rosé 'Marafiance', 2023** Château Cavalier, Provence, France £45.00
Classically pale pink, dry, crisp Provençal rosé with light touches of peaches, red berries and hints of citrus. **Magnum:** £90.00

75. **Primitivo Appassimento** Linteo, Puglia, Italy £28.00
A blockbusting richly flavoured red with a good concentration of ripe plum and black cherry fruits
76. **Ribera del Duero Roble, 2022** Protos, Ribera del Duero, Spain £43.00
Succulent, velvety and crammed full of blackberry fruitiness. Plums and spice burst from the glass with hints of liquorice.
77. **Chianti Classico, 2021** Borgo Salcetino, Radda-in-Chianti, Tuscany, Italy £45.00
Top notch Chianti from a classic, slow-ripening vintage. Deliciously ripe and juicy with vibrant flavours of tangy red cherry, sweet cassis, fig and roasted red pepper.
78. **Massaya 'Terrasses de Baalbeck', 2021** Massaya Estate, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon £57.00
A very elegant red with smoky, spicy fruit characters and a long, complex finish.
79. **Priorat 'Coma Vella', 2017** Mas d'En Gil, Tarragona, Catalunya, Spain £78.00
Old-vine Garnacha and Cariñena (Carignan) flourish on extremely poor soils resulting in a soft, supple red with bags of personality. This is a smoky, dense and intense red with spicy fruit. Nicknamed the 'Pomerol of Spain', it is perfect with roast meats or game.
80. **Brunello di Montalcino, 2019** Camigliano, Tuscany, Italy £90.00
An impressive and well-balanced Brunello from a very good vintage. Warm, sun-ripened cherry and berry fruit characters are underpinned by classic notes of liquorice, dried mushroom, toasted nuts and coffee bean. The palate shows impressive balance with perfectly integrated tannins and a long, slightly savoury finish.
81. **Barbaresco Asili, 2020** Ca' del Baio, Piedmont, Italy £95.00
An elegant, generous Barbaresco made from hand-picked grapes selected from prime areas of the Asili Cru. An intense, fruit-laden nose with notes of dried cherry, lavender, rose petal and aromatic herbs. The palate is soft and warm with velvety tannins and a long, dry finish.

83. **'Whistling Duck' Cabernet/Merlot, 2023** Calabria Family Wines, Griffith, New South Wales, Australia £28.00
Soft and very approachable red full of juicy black fruits, easy tannins and a spicy length.
84. **Richland 'The Black Shiraz', 2021** Calabria Family Wines, New South Wales, Australia £29.00
Aromas of ripe berry fruit and smoky oak give way to a medium-bodied wine with spicy, slightly earthy berry and plum fruit supported by supple oak tannins and a cracked black pepper finish.
85. **'Selkirk' Shiraz, 2021** Bremerton Estate, Langhorne Creek, South Australia £39.00
Complex aromas of vibrant red berry fruit and liquorice with well filled out clean fleshy fruit on the palate. Subtle use of oak has added complex creamy vanilla and fine underlying tannins.
86. **'The Vintage Widow' Pinot Noir, 2019** Jackson Estate, Marlborough, New Zealand £49.00
Pronounced cherry and raspberry aromas with lovely balance of fruit of the palate and a very elegant length.
87. **'The Barkly' Durif, 2016** Campbells, Rutherglen, Victoria, Australia £80.00
A dense, dark inky wine, this is Durif at its very finest. Rich and powerful with brooding plum and black cherry fruit, lifted notes of black pepper, cloves and spicy oak and fine-grained tannins.
88. **Coleraine, 2018** Te Mata Estate, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand £120.00
Rated (by the critics) as one of New Zealand's top five reds, this is a classic Bordeaux blend of 52% Cabernet Sauvignon, 33% Merlot, and 15% Cabernet Franc. Well structured and balanced with aromas of blackberries, currants and lavender, On the palate, it's superbly concentrated and elegantly layered, with tremendous fruit strength paired with complexity and detail and a long and intriguing finish.

90. **Merlot, 2022** La Palma, Rapel Valley, Chile £30.00
Classic Merlot with rich, ripe blackberry aromas leading onto a spicy, fruit laden palate.
91. **Altivo 'Classic' Malbec, 2023** Finca la Celia, Mendoza, Argentina £33.00
Ripe and smooth with full, gutsy fruit and softening tannins.
92. **Carmenère Reserva, 2022** Casas del Bosque, Rapel, Chile £37.00
An excellent example of this Chilean speciality. Aged for 10 months in French oak, it has a marvellous graphite quality reminiscent of the wines of Graves in Bordeaux. This brings a degree of freshness to the black cherry fruit which is wound round the heady notes of cedar, tobacco, cinnamon and plums.
93. **Merlot, Sandstone, 2019** Wente Vineyards, Livermore Valley, California, USA £42.00
A classic Merlot with delicate aromatics including dark cherry, ripe raspberry and cocoa powder. Refined and well-balanced with subtle tannins, finishing with a bright, refreshing acidity.
94. **Zinfandel, 2022** Edmeades Winery, Mendocino County, California, USA £55.00
Soft and supple with vivacious cherry fruit, this lovely red has a deep rural feel with great earthy notes and with a velvety complex structure.
95. **'One Point Five' Cabernet Sauvignon, 2017** Shafer Vineyards, Stags Leap District, Napa Valley, California, USA £170.00
